a. [1821 年次カタログ番号] (1821. inv.) のうち、アスタリスク(*)がついているものは原典由来の枝符號であり、ボールドになっているものは原典由来の内容削除項目であり、イタリックになっているものは我々が研究期間内で追跡しきれていないものを示し、必要に応じ [1821. Name] 欄を伸ばしている。なお、同一番号でシリーズになっているときは、個々の作品に [a], [b], [c], ... と枝符号を付した。

b. [1821 年次カタログ表示画家] (1821. Name) は、原典にあるとおりに記した。

c. [1885 年次来所蔵番号] (1885 inv.) は、次のカタログを出発点とする所蔵番号である。
